

How to organize a collection drive

when

Collections are held in the spring and fall. They are held on Saturdays or Sundays and run for 3 hours.

where

Centrally located sites with large parking lots work best. Access to buildings is advisable for restrooms or poor weather.

Market

Successful collections require strong marketing. P4P will create master files that your group can distribute.

Action

The day of the event we work with your group to process bikes for shipment and issue receipts. Materials and removal of items is provided.

Funding

We ask donors to provide a suggested 20-dollar donation with each item to offset shipping and operational costs. A tax-deductible receipt will be provided.

At the event, your group will help process bikes for shipment overseas. This hands-on experience includes taking off pedals and turning handlebars to make the bike as flat as possible for shipment. A demo will be held, and tools will be provided by P4P. Other volunteers will process receipts and greet donors, all material will be provided by P4P. A team of 6-10 volunteers is sufficient. Events run rain or shine.
