Dear Pedal People,

November 2025

Thank you for another amazing year of support as we continue our mission of sending donated bicycles and sewing machines to motivated people around the world. My favorite part of Pedals for Progress has always been the *tangibility* of the aid we provide to those in need. Each item donated by our supporters represents at least one individual who now has a better shot at life.

Your contributions don't just impact individuals. They also aid our community outreach organizations engaged in various projects that help people beyond the use of our bicycles and sewing machines. To show you the tangible difference your generosity has made, **here are the countries we shipped to in fiscal 2025:**

Belize: We made two shipments to *God Cares Outreach* in Belize, totaling 905 bikes and 90 sewing machines. Their network supports people from diverse backgrounds, cultures, and denominations, united in spreading hope, faith, love - and now, bicycles and sewing machines - to the people of Belize.

Guatemala: We shipped our 26th container, carrying 431 bikes and 30 sewing machines, to *FIDESMA*, our longest-running partner. The Foundation for Sustainable Development and the Environment provides community aid through various support programs and their ECOBICI bike shop.

Kosovo: We sent our second shipment of 436 bikes to GoBike. After a long pause due to COVID-19, GoBike has resumed operations with their community-focused bike shop serving people in Europe's young and growing nation of Kosovo.

Albania: We made our second and third shipment to Absolute Bikes Tirana, totaling 871 bikes and 70 sewing machines. Founded by former members of Ecovolis, this community driven shop promotes cycling, environmentalism, tourism, and philanthropy.

Uganda: Our Sewing Peace program made two shipments totaling 144 sewing machines to the Mityana Open Troop Foundation in Uganda, supporting their vocational training and education programs.

Thanks to your continued support, **we shipped 2,643 bicycles and 334 sewing machines** this fiscal year. Together, **we've helped more than 3,000 people while strengthening five community outreach organizations** that distribute these items and create lasting change in their communities.

As we enter the holiday season, please consider making a donation to Pedals for Progress to help us continue putting used bicycles and sewing machines to good use.
